## To the workers of the world

Taking into account that the First International Meeting of Workers in Solidarity with the Government and People of Venezuela held from August 29 to 31, 2019, and the World Meeting against Imperialism held from January 22 to 24, 2020, expressed the need to "Build a World Unitary Platform organized by continents, regions, sub-regions and countries in order to confront imperialism. This organizational structure will be shaped according to the peculiarities of each territory.

From Venezuela, the workers of the Motherland of Bolivar and Chavez, led by the proletarian president Nicolas Maduro Moros, the Vice Presidency of the Working Class of the United Socialist Party of Venezuela (VCO-PSUV) and the Bolivarian Socialist Central of Workers of the City, Countryside and Fishing (CBST-CCP), We call on the workers of the world and their organizations to unite and integrate the **Anti-Imperialist Working Class Platform**and thus take up the anti-imperialist cause united by social justice and respect for Mother Earth, the only alternative that is open to humanity to save itself and the planet.



Today we are in a better position to take up the causes of justice and social equality, but we need to gestate the rebirth of the working class movement at world level, with the power of proposal to confront neoliberalism and capitalism in the world, to raise the flag of social justice, welfare and socialism.

#### Who are we?

We are a movement that aims to contribute to the revival of anti-imperialist struggles of workers against the neoliberal project of globalization with a new social identity, from both a multiple and diverse perspective. These struggles have historically defined and built our identity according to the conditions imposed by imperialism on oppressed and colonized peoples. In this sense, we value the experiences provided by the historical struggles of the working class but also the struggles of the new social sectors that have emerged from the relations of production of neoliberal super-exploitation. We consider important the creation of new organizational forms of struggle, as well as the collective experiences of sovereign and independent socio-productive alternatives, such as popular economy, agro-ecological, eco-socialist, and workers' popular management projects.

#### What do we want?

We want to develop a process of articulation of our struggles that allows a rebirth of the movement of the world working class with power and capacity to create political-organizational proposals and social action that confront colonialism, neocolonialism and neoliberal capitalism in the world to achieve peace, justice and social welfare with sustainable development.

Our specific objectives are:

- To establish the bases for a plan of action that allows the inclusion, integration, articulation and direction of the diverse forms of organization and struggle
- To create an organizational body that can articulate all the organizational forms of the labor movement
- To collectively build a global and unitary agenda of struggle capable of integrating the key approaches of the different sectors of workers
- To promote solidarity actions of the working class worldwide for peace, independence, sovereignty and the peoples' right to self-determination
- To establish a network of workers in the world for the study, training and research in critical reflection and action, socialization and systematization of the socio-productive experiences and working class and popular struggles. This network should be articulated with the different educational institutions of workers.
- To advance in the overcoming of the diverse forms of exploitation of workers, through the promotion of new economic alternatives of popular economy, agro-ecology, eco-socialism and of popular, participative, democratic and a protagonist workers' management.




## What are our fundamental principles?

- The counter-hegemonic struggle against imperialism and colonialism to bring about the full independence of the peoples and to break with capitalist exploitation and political, social and cultural oppression.
- Defense of the right to self-determination of the peoples and the sovereignty and integrity of the territories and the right to create their own anti-capitalist, solidarity and communal forms of production.
- Safeguarding and defending cultural diversity against the processes of alienation and transculturation deployed by the United States and the European powers.
- International solidarity as a common identity and practical action of mutual support among the workers of the world

## What is our organizational vision?

The Platform is a movement of cooperating networks as the integral totality of multiple relationships between different member organizations and their activists. The working class is the transversal political subject to all these organizations and movements in their anti-imperialist and anti-colonial struggle from the world of work. Each network is made up of multiple nodes where dialogue, debate and agreement on proposals for struggle take place, seeking to give the struggle a global dimension.

The Platform can be established at four (4) levels: world, continental, regional and national.






Each level is a network in itself, which means that its development begins with a central network and from there on, new networks are created at the different territorial levels indicated. Therefore, its construction begins and is projected in the future from the central network (node) Venezuela, for being an anti-imperialist stronghold in Latin America.

At each territorial level, mechanisms should be established to enable dialogue for the systematization of experiences of organized struggle, as well as spaces for deliberation and agreement on actions that allow us to articulate struggles.

In this sense, three (3) forms of coordination and decision-making in the Platform's networks are envisage: (1) the General Assembly, where all the Liaison Committees are articulated and fostered to elaborate the general strategic plan of struggle at the national, regional, continental and world levels; (2) the Liaison Committee, as a particular strategic coordinator of the struggles and solidarities and promoter of the nuclei; and (3) the Nucleus, as a grassroots organization.

The promoting working group nucleus will be formed in each territory by means of a promoting assembly and will be constituted with a minimum of five (5) workers representing different organizational forms of the labor and popular movement. A coordinator or a coordinating team of the nucleus is to be elected from its midst. The coordinator will be the Main Spokesperson with voice and vote of the nucleus in the Promoting Liaison Commission. The Nucleus will be in charge of executing the general Plan of Struggle of the Platform.






# How do anti-imperialist organizations and militants relate to the Platform?
